The Challenge

To provide an antique brass finish on some very detailed and intricate areas. It needed to reflect the exclusive luxury called for in the design brief.

The Solution

Bradleys applied a real brass finish from their Metalite range, which was then handcrafted and aged accordingly.

The Detail

Situated in Mayfair opposite Claridge's, 33 Davies Street is a landmark building at the junction of Grosvenor and Davies Streets, sharing a block with 73 Brook Street. Its grand entrance features a hand-crafted bronze stair balustrade, each piece unique, reflecting a boutique hotel feel rather than a typical office. These Grade A offices hold a BREEAM 'Excellent' rating and won Best Commercial Building at the 2014 Brick Awards.
